

Faithful Navigator's August letter (sent to members by e-mail)

Worthy Sir Knights,

Let me start this message by thanking all of you for electing me your Faithful Navigator and your confidence in my abilities to lead our Assembly this coming fraternal year. I promise to do my best not to disappoint your trust in me.

The summer seems to be passing by so quickly and soon we will be active once again in Assembly business. While the Assembly membership takes a bit of a breather these past months, your executive have been busy preparing for the coming fraternal year. At a recent meeting with your executive and their Ladies we discussed a number of issues concerning our dinner meetings, the associated costs, and attendance. During this meeting it was agreed to try a different approach to our executive and general membership meetings. Here are some of the changes that will be implemented in September.

Executive meetings will continue to be held on the first Thursday of each month. Meetings will start at 7 pm with Mass at St. John the Baptist Church and the executive meeting will follow immediately after mass at a location in the church. All Sir Knights are welcome to attend these meetings.

General meetings will be held on the third Thursday of each month however there will be a change regarding meals. It was felt that, for several reasons, our dinner meetings would be discontinued on a monthly basis, and that having the membership gather from 5:30pm until 7:00pm for fraternal time would be preferable. In lieu of monthly dinner meetings it was agreed that the Assembly would host 2 pot luck dinners, one in the fall and one in the spring. The Ladies at this meeting were in unanimous support of this change and suggested this change. We will continue to have our Christmas Party and June BBQ as well when our Ladies will be in attendance.

As a result there will be no meal provided at the September meeting, but I encourage members to come out and socialize with their fellow Sir Knights prior to the meeting at 7:00 PM.

In regards to attendance at our monthly meetings I have felt that we needed to explore ways to increase the participation of our members. In this regard your executive discussed several incentives that we hope will increase participation of our members. These will be discussed and need to be passed at our meeting, but included, eliminating the 50/50 draw and replacing it with a full membership draw. Another was to carefully track attendance and provide free Christmas and/or BBQ tickets for the Sir Knight that consistently attended general membership meetings. (details of these will be discussed at our September meeting).

Increasing the Faith component within our Assembly was discussed and in this regard the Assembly will be holding "Corporate Communion Masses" at each of the Parishes under the umbrella of our Assembly. This will provide an opportunity for us as Catholic Gentlemen and ladies to be a visible sign to the community of our devotion to the Church. It is my desire to co-ordinate these Masses with Council breakfast. Members will be advised of dates and locations.
